



CVMS Halloween Costume Guidelines

Students may wear Halloween costumes to the school on Tuesday, October 31, 2017. There will a costume contest at lunch for those who choose to dress up. All costumes must adhere to the following conditions:

- Bobcat dress code enforced – no bare midriffs or “revealing” clothing, appropriate shoes must be worn, etc.
- You must be able to sit, walk, breathe, see and hear! (no masks that cover the face)
- Costumes cannot promote use of drugs, alcohol or weapons of any kind!
- No pretend “prop” weapons such as water pistols, knives or swords!
- All school rules will be enforced (i.e., no bikes or skateboards, etc.)
- Costumes may not be offensive or inappropriate in any way
- Masks are only permitted during costume contest while on stage.

Students who wear costumes that do not conform to the costume guidelines above, or the CVMS dress code, will be given loaner clothing and a call home will be made.
