

Announcement regarding the CVMS Parking Lot as of 2/13/17

Dear Parents and Community Members,

As of February 13, we are losing one of our back staff parking lots due to the upcoming construction at CVMS. Although renovations to our drama room and PAC as well as our new music building will not begin construction until June 17, 2017, we are entering the construction phase and must begin preparing the area for our new building.

Due to the loss of this lot, we will have to designate some spots in our front lot for CVMS Staff Parking ONLY. This will assure our teachers and staff have parking spaces each and every day. We know this will cause an inconvenience in our already small parking lot, but it is necessary to assure school employees have a place to park for work. Below is a description and some pictures indicating the new designated parking spaces.

*****Please note any non-staff vehicle parking in these spaces from 7:00 am - 3:30 pm may be ticketed or towed.***


The first row upon entering the parking lot will now be for CVMS Staff Parking Only. This includes the five spots on the small row on the other side as well. There will also be 4 spots painted for the Boys & Girls Club vans. These vans already park in the lot, but to assure they have spots in the afternoon, we will designate these four spots for the vans.



Staff who arrive early, such as our office staff, may park in other spots not designated for staff parking, but for those who arrive for our regular start time, at 8:30 am or later, such as our cafeteria workers, will have these spots available for them.

There will be signs posted as of Monday, February 13. On the morning of Tuesday, February 14, the parking spots will be painted beginning at 7:00 am. We believe these will be completed by 8:00 am and the paint used dries quickly. We will open this for employees ASAP.

Here is a bird's eye view of the school so you can see the areas that are for Staff Parking:



Thank you all for your patience and understanding as we put this plan into place. We have worked with district personnel to explore many options to accommodate our parking needs, and this is the best plan to implement as quickly as possible. We also have met with the Boys & Girls Club to find solutions to potential issues for this and the upcoming construction. We will work through the kinks and will provide information to staff and community as needed.

These parking spot designations will be in place through the rest of this year and for the 2017-18 school year. Once construction is complete, we can revisit parking areas for staff.
