Message from the Principal

Good Afternoon CVMS Families,

In recent weeks, the SDUHSD leadership team has received a variety of opinions from our stakeholders regarding school reopening plans. Despite many divergent views, I do believe we all share goals in the following areas:

- Health and safety for everyone.
- High-quality instruction and learning for students.
- Resources and professional development to ensure staff can successfully engage and support students.
- Opportunities for academic intervention, social emotional-support, student connectedness, and mental/physical health.
- Safely return ALL students to our campuses.

The Board of Trustees' September 17th decision, though not popular with everyone, was prudent, and it affords us the opportunity to continue with the quality of teaching and learning our students are receiving in a distance learning environment.

The Board's decision also allows us to embrace their directive to provide on-campus supports for targeted student populations in addition to exploring ways for students to engage in extracurricular activities that support their passions beyond the classroom. These supports and student connection activities will go a long way toward helping students not only be successful in distance learning, but support their social-emotional well-being.

While small groups continue to be phased onto campus, we recognize that this does not benefit ALL students. Therefore, as Superintendent Dr. Haley shared in yesterday's community message, the SDUHSD will reconvene an expanded reopening

important topic with your student. Help them identify the trusted adults in their lives and who they see themselves going to for help both in and out of school. In the presentation, we also talk about how important it is to NOT keep things secret should a friend or family member share that they are having suicidal thoughts. This is an idea that you can help reinforce at home. Often, we are able to intervene at school and literally save lives because students shared concerning things that other students had sent to them via text, email, or in social media posts. While this is never an easy topic to discuss, it is critical that our students know what to look for and how to help someone in need. We can help prevent suicides by working together and encouraging open and honest dialogue. Please reach out to your counselor if your student expresses a desire to hurt themselves or shares that they are concerned about someone else.
