BEHAVIOR	CONSEQUENCES
<p><u>RESPECTFUL:</u> Students will treat peers and all school staff with respect. This includes substitutes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention, Parent Contact, Behavior Contract • Habitual Infraction = Suspension, Parent Contact
<p><u>DEFIANCE:</u> Students will not willfully defy authority or disrupt academic or activity programs.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention, Suspension, Parent Contact • Habitual Infraction - Referral to *SST, Recommendation for Alternative School Placement
<p><u>ACADEMIC HONESTY POLICY:</u> Carmel Valley Middle School is committed to Academic Honesty. Students will do their own work. See District Policy (SDUHSD) on Page 11 in your student agenda book.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense – “Zero” on Assignment or Test, Academic Honesty Contract, Parent Contact • Continued offense – Suspension from school, *SST referral
<p><u>TRASH:</u> Students will eat lunch in designated areas and refrain from throwing food, littering, feeding the birds and engaging in horseplay.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offense = Trash pick up, Detention • Continued Offense = Detention, Parent Contact, Behavior Contract
<p><u>BIKES/SKATEBOARDS/HELMETS:</u> Students will not ride to school with more than 1 rider per bike/skateboard. Bikes/skateboards will not be ridden on school property. Bikes/skateboards will be stored & locked in designated bike area. Helmets must be worn.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense – Warning • 2nd offense – Detention, Parent Contact • 3rd offense – Revoke Privileges on Campus, Parent Contact
<p><u>BUS:</u> Students will behave appropriately and respectfully on the <u>bus</u>. See the SDUHSD Transportation Rules of Conduct.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense = Detention, Parent Contact • 2nd offense = Riding privilege revoked for one week, Parent Contact • 3rd offense = Riding privilege revoked for rest of quarter, Parent Contact
<p><u>GAMBLING/SELLING ITEMS:</u> Students will not gamble and/or sell items on campus.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offense = Detention, Parent Contact • Habitual Infraction - Suspension (1 - 3 days)
<p><u>GUM:</u> Students will not chew gum on campus. Bring mints for fresh breath.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense = Warning • 2nd offense = Detention • Continued offense = Parent Contact, Behavior Contract
<p><u>GLASS CONTAINERS:</u> Students will not bring glass containers on campus.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense = Warning • 2nd offense = Detention • Continued offense = Parent Contact, Behavior Contract

<p><u>MOBILE DEVICES</u></p> <p>They may be used at school to support learning. Use of technology in the classroom is at the discretion and under the supervision of each classroom teacher. Students may not use social media, take pictures or videos at school unless otherwise directed by a teacher. Abuse of this privilege (violation of the Acceptable Use Policy) may result in suspension of this privilege.</p> <p>*CVMS is not responsible for LOST or STOLEN items at school!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st confiscation: returned to student at end of the school day plus 30 min. detention • 2nd confiscation: electronic device released to parent with 60 min. detention • 3rd confiscation: electronic device released to parent and 120 min. detention • 4th confiscation: electronic device released to parent and conference with Administration/Parents to discuss revoking cell phone privileges. • Possession of a laser pen will result in confiscation and a detention. • Use of laser pen on another person = suspension

<p><u>INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:</u> Students will not use profanity, commit vulgar or obscene acts or engage in inappropriate displays of affection.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense - Warning, Behavior Contract, Detention • 2nd offense - Detention, Parent Contact • 3rd offense - Suspension, Parent Contact
<p><u>BULLYING/CYBERBULLYING:</u> Students will not bully, harass, intimidate or threaten staff or students in person or via any electronic method. Students are subject to consequences regardless of their intentions.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention, Behavior Contract, Parent Contact • Habitual Infractions: Suspension, Referral to *SST, Recommendation for Alternative School Placement • Law Enforcement Intervention
<p><u>PHYSICAL CONTACT:</u> Students will not fight or engage in intimidating behavior. Students will not engage in gags or inappropriate physical contact.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense – 1 to 5 Day Suspension, Possible Police Intervention, Parent Contact • 2nd offense – Referral to *SST, Recommendation for Alternative School Placement
<p><u>SEXUAL HARASSMENT:</u> Students will not engage in conduct constituting sexual harassment and/or sexual assault.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense – 1 to 5 Day Suspension, Parent Contact, Referral to *SST, Possible Police Intervention • 2nd offense – Referral to *SST, Recommendation for Alternative School Placement
<p><u>COMPUTER USE:</u> Students are expected to follow the guidelines for responsible computer use as outlined in the District “Acceptable Use Policy” (AUP).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removal from use of network, detention, suspension, Parent Contact, expulsion, police intervention (depending on nature and severity of infraction) • Removal from computer/multimedia class

<p><u>TOBACCO/NICOTINE:</u> Students will not use or possess tobacco or nicotine in any form including e-cigarettes or vapes at school, to and from school, or at school events.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense = **ATOD, Suspension, Possible Police Intervention, Parent Contact, *SST Referral • 2nd offense = Suspension, Police Intervention • 3rd offense = Recommendation for Alternative School Placement
<p><u>ALCOHOL/DRUGS:</u> Students will not possess or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs or possess paraphernalia (this includes drug and alcohol paraphernalia/look-a-likes) at school, to and from school, or at school events.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st offense = 5 Day Suspension, *SST Referral to Police Intervention, Parent Contact • 2nd offense = Referral to *SST, Recommendation for Alternative School Placement
<p><u>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES:</u> Students will not sell or furnish controlled substances.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 day suspension, Parent Contact, Referral to *SST, Police Intervention, Recommendation for Expulsion
<p><u>SCHOOL/PERSONAL PROPERTY:</u> Students will not steal, deface or vandalize school or personal property. This includes using other people’s lunch numbers.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 to 5 day suspension, Parent Contact, Restitution, Possible Police Intervention
<p><u>DANGEROUS EQUIPMENT:</u> Students will not possess weapons* of any kind or a facsimile of a weapon including paint ball equipment.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confiscation, 1 to 5 day suspension, Parent Contact, Referral to *SST, Possible Police Intervention, Possible Recommendation for Expulsion
<p><u>INCENDIARY DEVICES:</u> Students will not possess or use explosives/incendiary devices (including matches or lighters), pull fire alarms, or commit arson. Aerosol cans are <u>not allowed</u> on campus or in the locker rooms!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confiscation, 1 to 5 Day Suspension, Parent Contact, Possible Referral to Law Enforcement, Possible recommendation for Expulsion.
<p><u>WEAPON:</u> Students will not brandish a “weapon” or possess, sell or furnish a firearm.</p> <p>*A weapon can be any object with the potential to cause harm which is used to threaten or injure another person.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mandatory Expulsion, Parent Contact, Referral to Law Enforcement

L. O. P. (LOSS OF PRIVILEGE LIST)

If you are involved with a referral or LOP infraction, the administration may (at their own discretion), place your name on an LOP List. For the period of time your name is on the list, you may not participate in any extracurricular activities. This includes school dances, field trips, and night events.
