ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

We have seen an uptick in absences and tardies as the new semester begins. Please review the CVMS attendance and tardy policies with your student.

ATTENDANCE - Your student's daily attendance is an essential part of their education. When your student is absent you should call the school *each day of their absence*, not when they return to school. If you do not call, your student must provide a note. We need to know why your student is not at school.

ABSENCES - A student's absence must be cleared by a parent or guardian within 48 hours by way of (1) telephone verification (2) a note or (3) an email to the Attendance Secretary.

TARDIES - We review tardies on a two-week cycle. If a student is tardy for four or more class periods during those two weeks, they will receive a detention. Your student will be notified by administration and front office staff when and where the detention will be served.
