

Counselors' Corner

As a final reminder, if your Bobcat will not be attending CVMS for the second semester, please be sure and contact our registrar, Tracy Ngo at Tracy.Ngo@sduhsd.net so that she can initiate the check out process and give you all the information that you will need to enroll your student in their new school.

As high school selection is drawing near, we have been getting many questions from both students and families about which high school "is best". Though elective choices may differ, both Torrey Pines and Canyon Crest have the same core curriculum, cover the same state standards and both have amazing programs and reputations. What it really boils down to is the individual student preference and the way they prefer that the curriculum is presented. Many students prefer block days, similar to those we have here at CVMS which continue at Torrey Pines. Others prefer the 4X4 schedule of CCA, where there are only four classes at a time and these classes cover a years worth of work in a semester and students then wait until the following year to take the same subject. For example, they may take English 9 from August through December and then take English 10 from January to June the *following* school year. Another marked difference is that each school offers different Career Technical Education(CTE) Pathways for students who wish to take a deep dive into a specific subject matter. The include designated classes that students can take throughout their high school career and culminate in some type of capstone experience. This is a wonderful opportunity for students who want to further their education in a variety and definitely should be taken into consideration as you select a school.
