

## CVMS Digital Citizenship Plan

Students in each grade (7th and 8th) will receive a minimum of 5 hours of instruction per year covering digital literacy and citizenship skills. During the course of their middle school career, all students will receive lessons covering all of the CIPA-required topics (appropriate online behavior, safety and privacy, and cyberbullying). These modules have been produced by [Common Sense Media](#) and are being used in schools around the country. All lessons are 60 minutes, except for the combined “Creator’s Rights / Responsibilities”, which is 90 minutes.
